# Develop and Administer a School Community Student Needs Assessment (1)

- A yearly School Community Student Needs Assessment is required for WIOA, Title II AEFLA/EL Civics funded Agencies
- Agencies assess needs in
  - General Civic Participation topics (Civic Participation 231 funded)
  - Workforce related topics (IELCE 243 Funded)
- Results of this needs assessment inform the selection of the agency's Civic Objectives and Additional Assessment Plans (COAAPs).

# Develop and Administer a School Community Student Needs Assessment (2)

- **General Needs Assessment**

- Assess the needs of the student community as a whole.
- What EL Civics information do students need and want to learn?

- **Workforce Training Needs Assessment**

- Which career pathways do students want to follow?
- English language learners who wish to gain training and employment should be given a specifically designed needs assessment to determine placement in Integrated EL Civics and Workforce Training Courses (IELCE).

- **Optional: Classroom Needs Assessment**

- After the School Community Needs Assessment has informed the selection of COAAPs, assess the needs of a specific class.
- Use the results to select from the agency-chosen COAAPs

# Develop and Administer a School Community Student Needs Assessment (3)

- Needs assessment surveys can be done:
  - on paper
  - online (e.g. Survey Monkey, Google Forms, etc.)

# Develop and Administer a School Community Student Needs Assessment (4)

- Choose 2-4 Civic Objectives (CO) from each of the 7 competency areas on the [Pre-Approved Civics Objectives List](#):
  - Consumer Economics · Government and Law
  - Community Resources · Transition
  - Health · Employment
- The needs assessment will include approximately 12-24 Civic Objectives for students to choose from.
- The number of Civic Objectives used in the needs assessment may depend on the level of the student.

# Sample Civic Objectives

- **Consumer Economics:** CO 2 - Access community or commercial agencies to resolve a consumer complaint.
- **Health:** CO 26 – Identify/access free or low-cost medical, dental, and other health care services/insurance.
- **Government and Law:** CO 45 - Identify features of the legal system including individual rights, laws, and ordinances as well as procedures for obtaining legal help
- **Transition:** CO 52 - Research, identify and utilize soft skills (Personal Qualities, Customer Care Skills, Leadership Skills) necessary to succeed in post- secondary education, training and employment.
- **Workplace Training:** CO 70 - Demonstrate the language and literacy skills necessary to effectively participate in workforce training in early childhood education.

# Develop a School Community Needs Assessment

- Use the chosen Civic Objectives to design a needs assessment.
  - Beginning level learners need a picture-based assessment tool with simplified words.
  - Intermediate to Advanced level learners should have pictures and/or phrases or sentences.
    - Giving CO descriptions to students is not appropriate

# Administer a School Community Needs Assessment

- Administer the needs assessment to a majority of learners
- Ask learners to check their 3-5 top Civic Objectives of interest
- Tally the results.
- Use the results to choose 3 -10 Civic Objectives
- Review all the COAAPs related to the Civic Objectives chosen.
- Select the COAAPs that meet the needs of the students in content, level, and type of assessment (oral, written, etc.)
- Complete the [Needs Assessment Summary Form](#) to report the process and results of the needs assessment.

# Needs Assessment Summary Form

## Campbell Adult and Community Education (CACE)

At Campbell Adult and Community Education (CACE) we have 2 types of surveys we give to our community that we use to determine our curricular calendar and priorities for a given year. All ESL students take a version of our EL Civics Needs Assessment. We provide different versions of the needs assessment for 4 of the 5 levels of ESL at CACE. Beginning low (BL) students have a needs survey with pictures and short captions of the tasks they would work on in class for a related COAAP. For example, there is a picture of a man talking to his doctor, and the caption says “Talk to the doctor”. This survey option is related to COAAP 28.5. There are 12 options for students to pick from and we ask all students to vote for the 3 most important topics for them to study in their ESL class. This is a paper-based survey and it is translated into 8 different languages so it is more accessible for BL students. BL students are the only students who have access to a translated needs assessment. Beginning High (BH), Intermediate (IL/IH) and Advanced (Adv.) level ESL students take a different version of the needs assessment that are all google forms, with level appropriate descriptions of the tasks related to the COAAPs. The needs assessment for beginning high students has 15 options for students to choose from, the survey for IL/IH and Adv. have 17 options each. Each year the BL, IL/IH, and Adv. needs surveys change. We update the survey options based on which COAAPs were done the previous year so that we don’t have the same COAAPs chosen year after year. This is important because many of our students stay with us for multiple years, and we want to expose them to a variety of COAAPs. We also change the options based on relevant issues in the community like voting, if it is an election year, or telemedicine during the pandemic.

# Needs Assessment Summary Form (continued)

## Campbell Adult and Community Education

The EL Civics Curriculum Specialist creates the needs assessments and then shares them with teachers. Teachers post this survey into their LMS and the results for all students in that level are tabulated and kept in the EL Civics Curriculum Specialist google drive. This happens each year in March or April.

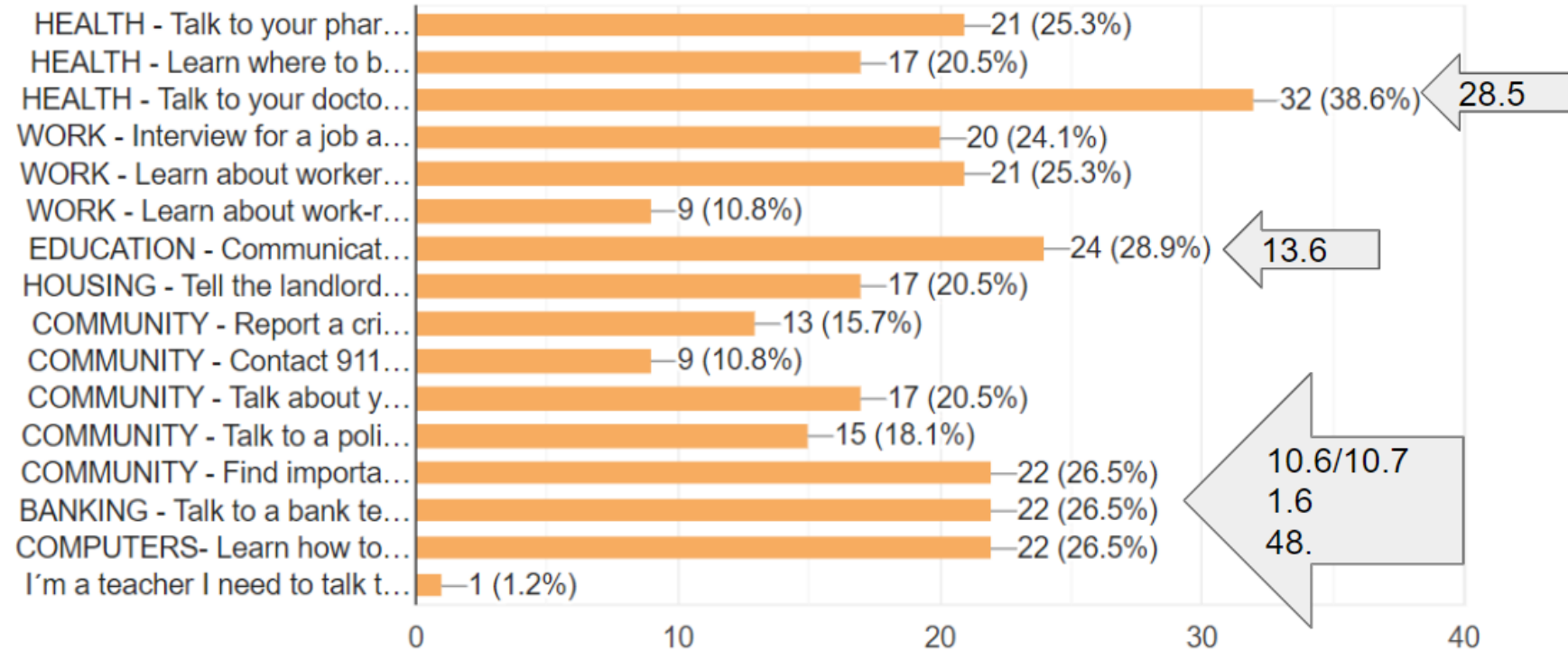
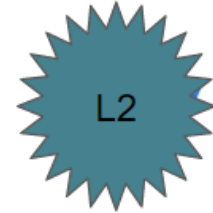
After all classes have administered their needs assessments, the EL Civics Curriculum Specialist, ESL Department Chair and Assistant Director of CACE analyze the results to see which options received the most votes. From there a calendar of COAAPs is created for the following school year. The majority of the COAAPs that make it onto the calendar are the top vote getters. However, there are some exceptions. For example, in 2019 the Census was not an option on the survey, but we knew how important the information and skills associated with this COAAP were. We added the Census COAAP to our calendar anyway and completed it with students in late winter of 2020, right before the actual Census began. The same thing happened with our Telemedicine unit. We created the revised the COAAP under the direction of Lori Howard at CASAS, and added it to our EL Civics Calendar for the fall of 2020 because we knew how relevant the material was in the middle of stay-at-home orders, and remote learning due to the Covid 19 pandemic.

# Develop and Administer an IELCE School Community Needs Assessment

- Develop and Administer an IELCE School Community Needs Assessment
- Survey community for job opportunities
  - Utilize Information from CTE, WIB and School Advisory Committees
- Decide which job training your agency or partner agencies can offer related to job opportunities
- Discuss with CTE/ESL teachers what level of ELLs could participate in training with English support
- Develop a needs assessment related to that job training.
- Administer the assessment to learners interested in job training.
- Utilize the results to inform your agency's selection of training programs to offer
  - Select or create COAAPs which best support the training offered
    - Example Workforce preparation COAAPs
      - CO 37 or 52 Soft Skills
      - CO 33 Get or keep a job skills
    - Example workforce training COAAPs:
      - CO 70 Early Childhood Education
      - CO 71 Health Care
      - CO 72 Building/Construction Safety
      - CO 73 Information Technology
      - CO 74 Manufacturing/Machine Tech
      - CO 75 Accounting
