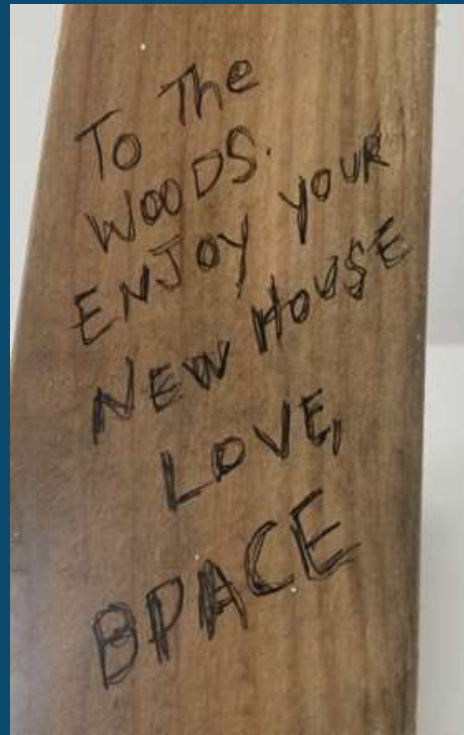
Contextualized Learning Explorations: From Skills to Service
