

- Five-week noncredit guidance course
- Taught by a MSJC Adult Ed Counselor
- Topics include: Career Research, Defining Success, College Research, Goal Setting, Resume Writing, Interview Skills, MBTI

College and Career Planning Class with Soft Skills

- Stand alone or paired with career class
- If paired with career class, instruction is tailored to meet industry soft skill needs of career students in cohort
- Topics include: top skills needed in your industry workplace, what employers are looking for in your industry, writing an effective resume and interviewing effectively for your industry
- Meeting the real time training needs of students in our career classes
- Students earn NC certificate of completion with CCPS + Career model
