Enhancing Learner Persistence in Distance Learning

By converting all classes into technology-driven distance learning models, learner persistence was enhanced in all programs despite the low enrollment.

- NRS Persister report shows that EFL Gains on Table 4 increased by 7.47%,
- EFL Gain Table 4B increased by 6.91%,
- the Average attendance hours increased for both ESL and ABE programs, and
- teachers are poised to teach blended, distance, or traditional classes using Canvas Learning Management System (LMS) school wide for the 2021-22 school year.

Successful Remote CASAS Assessment

- ➤ Elk Grove staff trained up on how to do remote testing in order to assist students and meet their needs.
- ➤ Our staff collaborated with CAERC consortium members to assist others with "how to" do successful remote assessments at their sites.
- ➤ EGACE staff and proctor leaders successfully pre-tested **605** participants. By January 2021, our staff successfully post-tested **73%** of participants.
- ➤ Qualitative student data illustrates that remote testing lowers students' affective filter.



Digital Literacy Skills Classes

With over 75% of our students being enrolled in ESL classes, and majority of our students being in a low socioeconomic — high poverty area, we realized there was a strong need for digital literacy skill development at our school. As a result, we...


- Developed 5-class time workshops in the mornings and evenings (with social distancing)
- Added 4 more workshops since November 2020
- Retained 64% of our low level ESL students during this pandemic year.

Online Registration and Remote Testing

During the pandemic, HLP students self-enrolled online. Directions were provided in English, Chinese, and Spanish.

Before beginning their classes, students took CASAS pre-tests remotely.


- Students read through testing guidelines and agreed.


Response to Employer Workplace Safety Concerns & Student Needs

Support is Key


- 1) college transitions managers and counselors work with SBAS program specialists and counselors to transition students into the college,

San Mateo Adult & Career Education Remote Testing Procedures and Process

Our goal was to remote test as many students as possible during the pandemic. Our processes and procedures...

- helped improve our accountability and assessments for our testing and student evaluation, which we use for determining students level to place them in classes and next level promotion.
- allowed us to test as many students as possible (57% of our ESL and ABE students) which resulted in us being able to have a better program management regarding CASAS testing.

Become A Home Care Aide – Job Fair

A Job Fair is held at the end of each 10 week/35 hour online "Become a Home Care Aide" class.

- It gives the students the opportunity to meet prospective employers and to learn about each of the participating agencies
- To attend, students must complete all course requirements, by attending all classes, passing all unit assessments with a score of 90% or above, passing the EL Civics COAAP 71.1, and taking CASAS pre and post-tests.



Drive -In Testing Increased Our Outcomes During the Pandemic

COVID-19 closed our 3 campuses to any in-person testing. We followed the Novi Adult Ed. model for drive in testing (DIT) posted on the CASAS website to increase the number of students we could reach in a more efficient time.

- 2-3 certified proctors present for approximately 15 students in a three-hour shift.
- a 20% increase in students tested since only remote testing one-to-one.
- students willingly sign up for appointments online or by phone.
- a majority of 57% of students with paired CASAS scores.

Victor Valley Adult Education Regional Consortium Regional Graduation


Annually Victor Valley College hosts a regional graduation for 5 schools combined. The graduation celebration...
