Email

- Gmail, Outlook (formerly Hotmail), Yahoo Mail, and others

Microsoft Office

- Google Drive is used for file storage.
- Check and see if your district is using Google Workspace for Education and your level of access.
- There is a free version of [Google Workspace for Education](#) with the basic tools.

Forms, surveys, questionnaires, checklists

- Google Forms or Microsoft Forms, which can be turned into quizzes
- Commercial products, such as [Wufoo](#), [Jotform](#), [SurveyMonkey](#), and others – create a free account, or upgrade to a subscription with more features and options.

Infographics software

- Create free accounts at [Canva](#), [Piktochart](#), [Venngage](#), and others.
- Upgrade to a subscription with more features and options.

Learning management system

- This includes Canvas, Moodle, Schoology, Google Classroom, Blackboard, and others.

Templates

- Explore whether the digital resource has templates that you can quickly modify, rather than having to start from scratch.
