## **USE AUTHENTIC LANUGAGE**

- With scaffolding, any level student can use authentic language.
- EL Civic Objective 46.13 Identify and describe safe food practices (e.g. preventing cross contamination of foods and food preparation/storage spaces, etc.).
- Not designed for low beginning, but authentic and useful.
- Objective was to help students learn to read the CDC website. I did a series of classes on this website.





## INTERACTIVTY LESSON PLAN


- 1. Make a list of review words that can be found in a house.


