Overview - History

 Originally funded by a grant from the federal Office of Vocational and Adult Education: "Can adults learn English online?" (Yes!)

- Launched in 2008; SCOE given ownership after a competitive process
- Upgraded several times
- Committed to keeping it FREE (thus, the ads)

- Number of website visitors: 14 Million




- Average amount of time per visit: 23 minutes



Changes to the Civics Test

1 Important Updates to the Naturalization Test and New Study Materials for the 2020 Version of the Civics Test

USCIS has revised the civics portion of the naturalization test. Read below for more information and to find study materials with the new 128 questions and answers from the 2020 version of the civics test.

Which civics test will I take?	
Applicable Civics Test for Naturalization	
Naturalization Application Filing Date	Applicable Test at Initial Exam, Re-exam, or N-
Before Dec. 1, 2020	2008 version of the civics test
On or after Dec. 1, 2020	2020 version of the civics test

What happens during the interview?

English speaking

- Small talk
- General speaking throughout the interview

U.S. History and Civics test [Recent changes!]

- 2008 version: 10 questions from the USCIS <u>list of 100 questions</u>. Must correctly answer 6+.
- 2020 version: 20 questions from the <u>list of 128 questions</u>. Must correctly answer 12+.

Reading and Writing test

• Read one sentence out loud and write one sentence in English. Get 3 chances to read and 3 chances to write one sentence correctly. It's on the iPad now!

Questions about your N-400 Application for Naturalization

- Are you eligible for citizenship?
- Are you telling the truth? Do your answers match the ones you wrote on the N-400?
- Are there errors on your N-400 application?
- Are there changes, such as a new address or a new workplace?

Challenges?

- Difficult vocabulary (and lots of it!)
- English speaking small talk
- Part 12: "Have you EVER...?"
- Questions about illegal activities
- "Time outside the U.S." questions
- Stress of the interview / unknowns








Start a New Class






Class Details






Class Key






Learner Enters Class Key - 1






Learner Enters Class Key - 2

Remote Learning Ideas

From Jacqueline Vulcano, ESL Instructor from Central Wyoming College:

Host a Zoom meeting: Target speaking practice around topics and vocabulary covered in the lesson (from the course's Scope & Sequence).


What a great use of Zoom!



Remote Learning Ideas

Texting apps / email: Teacher can use Remind or another app to send out an assignment (e.g. "Complete Unit 1"). Include the USA Learns login link. Students can respond back with a picture of their score(s) to show completion.

WhatsApp & Facebook Messenger too






Remote Learning Ideas

LMS: Create a course in your LMS using the course structure of the citizenship course.

- Create an assignment: Students reply with a photo of their

completion score.
