# Math Item Level Field Testing

### Purpose

To examine the performance and reliability of new Math GOALS Assessment Items

### Eligible Participants

- ABE / ASE students
- New students and existing students are eligible to participate

### Methodology

- Students will be administered a new CASAS Math GOALS locator followed by a Math GOALS item level test.
- On the same day or within one week, each student may be administered a second and a third field test form.
- As with the first test event, the second and subsequent field tests will be administered following all standard test administration protocols.
- It is permitted to give more than one field test on the same day. CASAS recommends a short break between level tests.

### Technology Requirement

- Agencies must have computers, laptops or Chromebooks.
- The field tests may be administered in-person or remotely.

### Time Commitment

- The study will consist of one, two or three testing events. Each level test takes approximately 60 minutes.
- To be sure students have adequate time to complete the level tests, administrators should allow 90 minutes for the first testing event. This includes 15 minutes to complete the demographic information and 15 minutes for the locator.
- Administrators should allow up to 75 minutes for the second and third testing event.
