Reading and Listening for ESL Final Forms Field Testing

Study Participation Guidelines 2022

Purpose

To examine the performance and validity of the test forms at each test level of the new CASAS Listening and Reading for ESL Series.

Eligible Participants

- ESL students and ABE/ASE students whose first language is not English.
- Students may participate in Listening or Reading or both.

Methodology

- Following all standard test administration protocols, students will be administered a new CASAS Locator. (When paper testing, students will be administered an Appraisal field test.)
- Students will then take the appropriate level test based on the Locator / Appraisal results.
- Each student may also be administered a second level test.
 - It is permitted to give both tests on the same day. CASAS recommends a short break between level tests.
 - The second level test must be given within one week of the first test.
 - As with the first testing event, the second test will be administered following all standard test administration protocols.
 - With CASAS eTests the second level test may or may not be at the same level as the first.

Time Commitment

Students should be allowed 15 minutes for the Locator and 90 minutes for each level test to ensure they have adequate time to complete the tests. (When paper testing, students should be given 45 minutes to complete the appraisal.)
