1. Test drive the [SIMULATION Server](#) (optional)
2. Confirm [System Compatibility](#) to meet minimum specifications
3. Submit an [Online Site Agreement](#)
4. [Order](#) online test administrations (aka WTUs/web-test units)
5. Complete [Staff Preparedness: CASAS Implementation, Coordinator](#) and [Proctor](#) certifications
6. Request activation of “*live online testing*” account (e-mail techsupport@casas.org) (requires completion of steps 3 – 5)
7. (If desired) Import data from an external source
8. [Register Computers](#) to use for testing
9. [Create Sessions](#) based on recommended best practices
10. Begin to [Manage Sessions](#) and [Administer Tests](#)
