

Fremont Adult and Continuing Education:

New in 2017-2018

Pharmacy Technician Preparatory Course

- Pathway to Careers in Pharmacy Technology
- 12-week 60-hour course prepares for MVROP Pharmacy Technology Certificate Course
- Developed by FACE ESL Staff in collaboration with MVROP CTE Instructor

Bankwork\$ Career Training Course

- Pathway to Careers in Business and Finance
- Intensive 8-week 168-hour course prepares bank tellers, customer service representatives, and personal bankers
- Offered by JVS at FACE 3-4 times per year; developed in collaboration with local

Pharmacy Technician Preparate Course

Successes

- Part of a viable pathway; prepares for workforce training
- Curriculum is aligned with workforce training and with COAAP 30.4.
- Other options at FACE for workforce training in Health Careers (CalRegional EMT, Phlebotomy, and Medical Assistant Courses)

Challenges

- Not scheduled concurrently with the MVROP Pharmacy Technology Program
- More counseling and tutoring support is needed to keep students focused on attaining goals
- Closer collaboration with CalRegional is needed
- High School Diploma requirement

SOLUTIONS

- 1. An IELC companion course for the fall-white 2018-2019 MVROP Pharmacy Technology cohort
 - A 60-hour course with contextualized curriculum
 - COAAPs 52.2 and 30.4
 - All ELLs required to take the course
 - Ongoing Transitions Counselor support
 - Convenient scheduling and free babysitting
- 2. Distance Learning Online Career Prep Options
 - Relevant Units in Burlington English "English in America"
 - Burlington English Health Career Courses
 - Online Lab available

Bankwork\$ Career Training Course



Successes

- First cohort started on March 19 & graduated on May 10
- FACE students were interviewed by bank reps on May 10
- 70% of the interviewees secured banking positions

Challenges

- Scheduling conflicts
- Some advanced ESL students couldn't meet Bankwork\$ entrance qualifications
- ESL students with banking or business backgrounds from home countries want higher level jobs
- High School Diploma

SOLUTIONS

- 1. An IELC companion course to be pilotector for summer 2018 cohort
 - 48-hour course with contextualized curriculum
 - COAAP 52.2
 - All ELLs required to take it
 - Ongoing Transitions Counselor support
 - Convenient scheduling and free babysitting
- 1. Distance Learning Online Options
- BE Business English, BE Banking English, BE Office English, BE Finance English
- Pathway to be extended to higher level banking careers
