Levels of Teaching Integration

Polite Partners

Level One

No interruptions or transitions

Teacher 1 demonstrates/lectures. Teacher 2 takes simple notes in the front. Mini attention grabbing introductions are done together.

Congenial Colleagues



Level Two

Some interruptions for clarification and emphasis.

No transitions.

Teacher 1 demonstrates/lectures. Teacher 2 takes notes and interrupts with clarification questions. T 2 models questions students may be afraid to ask.

Productive Pals



Level Three

Intentionally integrated instruction.

Interruptions as necessary. Add planned stops and transitions.

Planned stops might be signaled by specific vocabulary words. When Teacher 1 mentions a particular word, baton passes to Teacher 2 who explains the meaning of the word, or address another point.

BFFs



Level Four

Fully integrated instruction.

Natural interruptions and transitions

(Matches I-Best teachers)

Teachers plan a single presentation that has one content and one language objective. Both content and basic skill lessons are integrated with natural or spontaneous stops.




SUCCESSES AND CHALLENGES


