QuickSearch provides an essential link between assessment and instruction in the CASAS system. Take this opportunity in a lab setting to become familiar with QuickSearch Online for:

The National Report System (NRS) requires all states to submit accountability information annually. Prerequisite: CASAS Implementation Basics



WSCS training is for workforce development professionals interested in offering work-readiness certificates. The training covers WSCS basic skills and soft skills assessments, curriculum and instructional resources, profiling of academic and soft skills, and preparing learners for certification. WSCS incorporates both the academic and soft skill needs of the workplace.

Strengthen your community's pipeline for a skilled workforce by learning how to collaborate with employers to develop workforce skill profiles that document basic and soft skills. With this information, education and training providers can customize existing programs in their region to better prepare job seekers.

This session is appropriate for Workforce development professionals who have completed CASAS Implementation Basics Training.

♦ California Accountability for WIOA, Title II, Programs
