- Describe and demonstrate how the agency/partnerships/consortium has developed and designed Career Pathways in an Integrated EL Civics program
 - Describe career pathways (Health Science Medical Technology, Hospitality, Tourism & Recreation, etc.)
 - o Describe partnerships (WIOA partners, CTE programs, AEBG partners, local employers)
 - o Describe the Integrated EL Civics COAAPs used in the program
 - o Demonstrate any outcomes achieved thus far

The poster session is scheduled for **Thursday June 13, 2019, 7:30-9:15 am in the Grand Ballroom**.

Displays represent a portion of the outstanding agency-developed materials and resources in use today in adult classrooms. At each table the presenters display curriculum or materials and answer questions concerning development of, use of and access to materials.

- Presenters will be provided with a 6-foot skirted table to display their materials.
- Presenters may use any type of display they wish. Many presenters use a tri-fold display board (similar to science fair presentations) highlighting their "Best Practice." We encourage displays to include pictures, video, and technology if applicable.
- There is limited access to electrical outlets; indicate on your submission document if you need power.
- Plan to bring 100 copies of handouts describing the curriculum or promising practice and contact information.
- Display tables should be staffed for the entire session by someone from the organization or agency that is able to explain and discuss the display.
- The room will be available for setup on Wednesday evening and Thursday morning.

We will be video-taping the Poster Session presenters talking about their best practice / poster. The video will be used on the CASAS Web site to promote the best practice and make the information available to those who were not able to attend the session. <u>Video interviews will be done during the Thursday morning Poster Sessions.</u>
