- Participating in the planning and design of large and small-scale assessment projects for use in adult education and workforce development programs
- Collaborating on construction of linear, computer adaptive, and performance-based assessments
- Coordinating with subject matter experts and assessment specialists to conduct item development activities and SME panel reviews





- Producing technical documentation related to assessment development projects
- Developing and conducting assessment-related training sessions and presentations at meetings and conferences
- Participating in professional development workshops and conferences

Qualifications:

- Master's Degree in TESOL, Adult Education, Applied Linguistics, Educational Measurement, Educational Psychology, English or related field
- Experience in adult basic education, ESL, or related programs, and familiarity with cultural and language backgrounds of Englishlanguage learners
- Experience writing and editing high-quality test items, preferably for an organization developing standardized assessments
- Strong familiarity with high-school level math concepts (preferred).
- Experience developing and scoring performance-based assessments (preferred).
- Experience in curriculum development in adult basic education, ESL, or related content areas (preferred).
