Karla Ramos, an NEDP 2023 scholarship finalist, encompasses the true essence of *Changing Lives*. Karla, a hard-working mother of three, shares her story of perseverance, commitment, and success.

Getting my high school diploma at 37 took a lot of determination, perseverance, and self-discipline. It wasn't easy to balance my family responsibilities, personal commitments, finances, and studies, but I stayed committed to my personal growth. As a parent, earning my diploma meant a lot to me, especially in terms of being a positive influence on my children.



I have a 4-year-old, a 15-year-old, and an 18-year-old who just graduated in the class of 2023. It was important for me to show them the importance of education and be a role model they could look up to. Having the chance to get my diploma at the same time as my teenage daughter was a unique and exciting experience. I had to carefully plan and manage my time to balance my own studies and support my daughter during her senior year and college preparations.
