


#### How Adults Learn: Using Androgogical Theory to Promote Engagement and Retention of Students





## NEDP HELPED THIS MOM, WIFE, AND MOTHER FIND HERSELF

Joanna's story resonates with the heart of the NEDP Changing Lives Scholarship – providing opportunities for individuals to rediscover their potential and pursue their dreams. NEDP is proud to share Joanna's story in her own words:

I lost myself somewhere between 20 and 48 years of age. I became a traveler, a wife, a mother, and a volunteer with the National Ski Patrol which ultimately led me to get my High School Equivalency Diploma and apply to college.

My desire to do better for my children and to set an example of following your dreams, and not losing yourself in life, led me to the CASAS NEDP program. I collected all my courage and decided to reach out to the BOCES Adult Learning Center in Elmira NY. I was fortunate to have met a very kind and encouraging instructor, who worked with me and encouraged me to take the plunge and complete the NEDP program.



Due to my life experience, and the fact that I was motivated and organized, the CASAS NEDP program was the right program for me at the time. I could work independently at home, and work at my own pace, which allowed me to continue to work and take care of my family.

Motivation and support made a tremendous difference in being able to work through the modules. The course modules were organized in small increments making them easier to complete and continue on in my own time. I could not have been prouder when my mail arrived confirming I had completed the program and earned my high school equivalency diploma. The same day I applied to Elmira college, in the hope of being accepted in the highly regarded nursing program.

I have now finished my first year as a full-time student at Elmira college with a major in Nursing which I hope to graduate from in 2027 with a BSN, while also being a mom, working and ski patrolling with a 4.0 GPA. I would have never gotten this far without the NEDP the CASAS Program offers. I was accepted in college last year only because I could show my certificate. This really helped the college to determine that I was motivated and prepared enough to attend their school.

Taking the NEDP showed me that despite all my commitments being a mother of two, and working to support my family, I had the potential to do better. As an adult learner it is hard to have the confidence to pick up your dreams and start something new. The NEDP builds up your confidence as you work through each module, and complete little sections every day. It boosts your confidence, because you work through a module and know you have completed it before accessing the next one. That way you know that you can in fact really do it, and you can finish your high school equivalency diploma, which is the first step to secondary education. Boosting the student's confidence is a very important part of the program, because most adults can in fact achieve secondary education if they work for it, but having the confidence to do it is all that holds them back.
