AGE REQUIREMENT: Minimum of age 18, unless stated otherwise.	
RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT: Must reside in NYS for 30 days, but some NEDP agencies also require clients to reside in geographic location of the agency, as noted.

1199 SEIU Training Fund – NYC	1199 Members only.
Action for a Better Community	Residents of Monroe and Ontario Counties only. Income criteria may apply.
Brooklyn Public Library	NYC clients, and may serve residents outside of geographic region, as agency staffing permits.
CAMBA	CAMBA clients only.
Cayuga-Onondaga BOCES	21 years of age; must reside within Cayuga-Onondaga BOCES district.
Cortland Community Action Program (CAPCO)	Must reside in Cortland County.
Dr. Derrick Griffith CUNY Preparatory School	Must reside with NYC CUNY Prep geographic region.
Eastern Suffolk BOCES	21 years of age, or 18 with an Equivalency Aid letter; must reside in Eastern Suffolk BOCES district.
Erie1 BOCES	21 years of age; must reside within Erie County.
Gerard Place	May serve residents from outside their geographic region.
Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES	Residents of Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES district; may serve residents outside of geographic region if over age 21 as agency staffing permits.
Herkimer-Fulton-Hamilton-Otsego BOCES	21 years of age; must reside in Herkimer-Fulton BOCES district.
Lantern Community Services	Lantern clients only.
Long Beach Adult Learning Center	Local geographic region; may serve residents outside of geographic region, as staffing permits.
Madison-Oneida BOCES	Residents of Madison-Oneida BOCES district; may serve clients outside its geographic region if over age 21 as agency staffing permits.
Onondaga-Cortland-Madison (OCM) BOCES	21 years of age; residents of Onondaga-Cortland-Madison (OCM) BOCES district only.
Orleans Niagara BOCES	21 years of age; serves clients both in and out of geographic region, as agency staffing permits.
Quality Services for the Autism Community (QSAC)	NYC residents who meet agency criteria.
Queens Public Library	21 years of age; may serve residents outside of geographic region as agency staffing permits.
St. Lawrence Psychiatric Center (SLPC)	SLPC residents only.
Tompkins-Seneca-Tioga (TST) BOCES	21 years of age; must reside in Tompkins-Seneca-Tioga (TST) BOCES district.
Wayne – Finger Lakes BOCES	21 years of age; must reside in Wayne – Finger Lakes BOCES district.
Western Suffolk BOCES	Age 18 or older; residents of Western Suffolk BOCES district only.
Women in Need, Inc. (WIN)	Age 18 or older; active WIN clients only.
Yonkers Public Schools	Residents of Yonkers City School District only.
