

NYS NEDP Agencies	Age and Residency Requirements
<b><u>AGE REQUIREMENT:</u> Minimum of age 18, unless stated otherwise.</b>	
<b><u>RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT:</u> Must reside in NYS for 30 days, but some NEDP agencies also require clients to reside in geographic location of the agency, as noted.</b>	
1199 SEIU Training Fund – NYC	1199 Members only.
Brooklyn Public Library	NYC clients, and may serve residents outside of geographic region, as agency staffing permits.
Cayuga-Onondaga BOCES	21 years of age; must reside within Cayuga-Onondaga BOCES district.
Destination Tomorrow	18 years of age; will serve clients outside their area.
Eastern Suffolk BOCES	21 years of age, or 18 with an Equivalency Aid letter; must reside in Eastern Suffolk BOCES district.
Gerard Place	Serves entire Buffalo community.
Goodwill of Finger Lakes	18 years of age; may serve residents outside of geographic region as agency staffing permits.
Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES	18 years of age; must reside in the Greater Southern Tier BOCES district.
Long Beach Adult Learning Center	May serve residents of Long Beach or Island Park (age 18 and above) as well as residents outside its geographic region (age 21 and above) as agency permits.
Madison-Oneida BOCES	18 years of age; must reside in the Madison-Oneida BOCES district.
Onondaga-Cortland-Madison (OCM) BOCES	21 years of age; residents of Onondaga-Cortland-Madison (OCM) BOCES district only.
Orleans Niagara BOCES	18 years of age; must reside in the Orleans Niagara BOCES district.
Queens Public Library	21 years of age; may serve residents outside of geographic region as agency staffing permits.
Tompkins-Seneca-Tioga (TST) BOCES	21 years of age; must reside in Tompkins-Seneca-Tioga (TST) BOCES district.
Syracuse City School District Adult Education	18 years of age; residents of Syracuse City School district only.
Western Suffolk BOCES	Age 18 or older; residents of Western Suffolk BOCES district only.
