EGACE Best Practice- We plant the seed on day 1!

- Student complete an online registration form, which is posted on our website. We collect all demographic information including cell phone carrier, goals and employment status.
- Prospective students complete a "Voluntary Authorization To Share Social Security Number" form at our in-person orientation. We have this form translated in several different languages.
- We inform students that their information is kept confidential.
- Students are assured they're not obligated to give their SSN, if they are not comfortable sharing.
- We inform students that if they choose not to provide their SS #, we will be reaching out to them via texts or/and email a couple months after they leave to follow up on their employment and earnings.
- We explain the importance of responding to our outreach.
- Teachers remind students that they may receive a survey when they leave our school.

Modalities

TOPs Enterprise

Using TE's Core Performance Wizard a report is generated with students to verify for qualification and invitations to survey is sent.

Google Spreadsheet

A week after the first invitation is sent (via TE) a list is created with students who haven't responded and shared with the office staff, reception and available proctors.

Google Form Link Emailed


A link to the EGACE Student (Former) Outcome Report (survey questions) is sent to students who haven't responded to TE invitation. Staff members continuously check and mark answers on the Shared Google Sheet.


Phone Calls

Data team, reception, and proctors make calls to students on the list when time is available.
