

Appendix - Old Chromebooks

One way to know whether or not your Chromebook is compatible with eTests2 is to try upgrading to ChromeOS version 128. If your Chromebook prevents you from upgrading then you cannot use that Chromebook for eTests2.

Another way to verify is to first uncheck the checkbox that says: Go directly to this site when the application is started. See red arrow in this graphic.



After unchecking this box you can try the eTests2 menu options (not shown in this graphic). If you get stuck on a white page that says Loading... that means your Chromebook is <u>not</u> compatible with eTests2.

In this case, select the proper site for your location that does <u>not</u> say eTests2, for example, select **eTests Online Global** instead of **eTests2 Global**.
