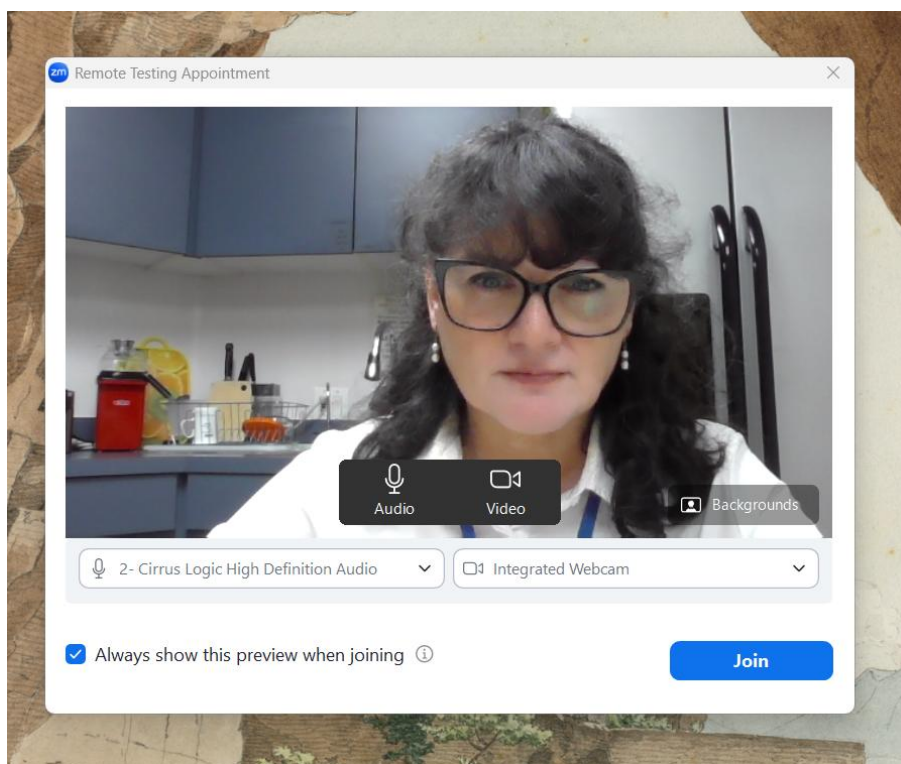


Remote Testing Directions for Students using Zoom

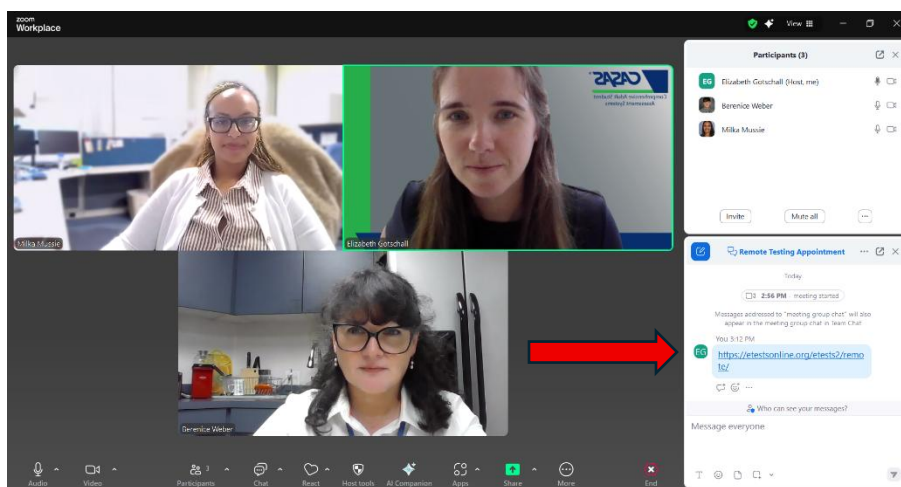
- 1 Join the Zoom meeting with your proctor.

Make sure that your video and audio are turned on. They will need to stay on while you are testing.

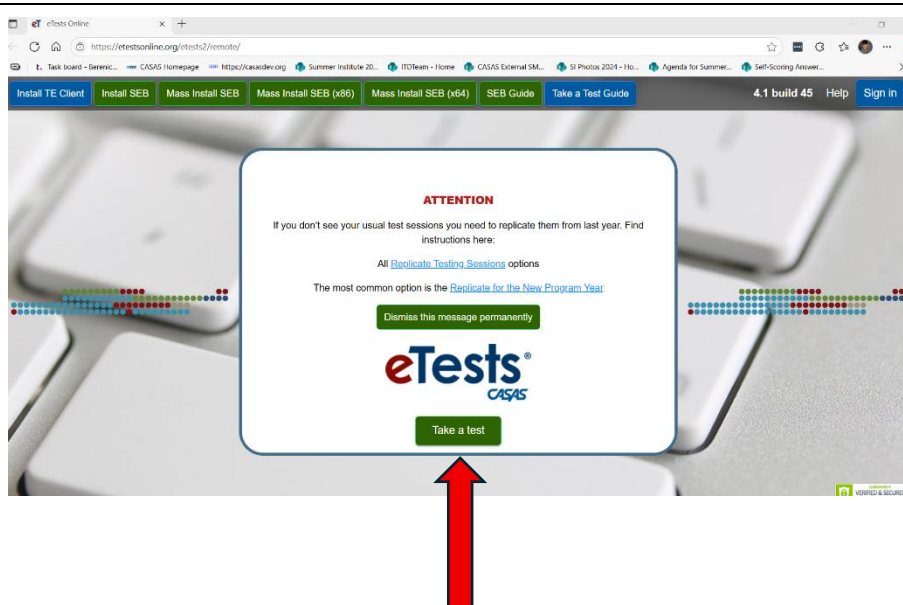


- 2 Your proctor will share a link in the chat.

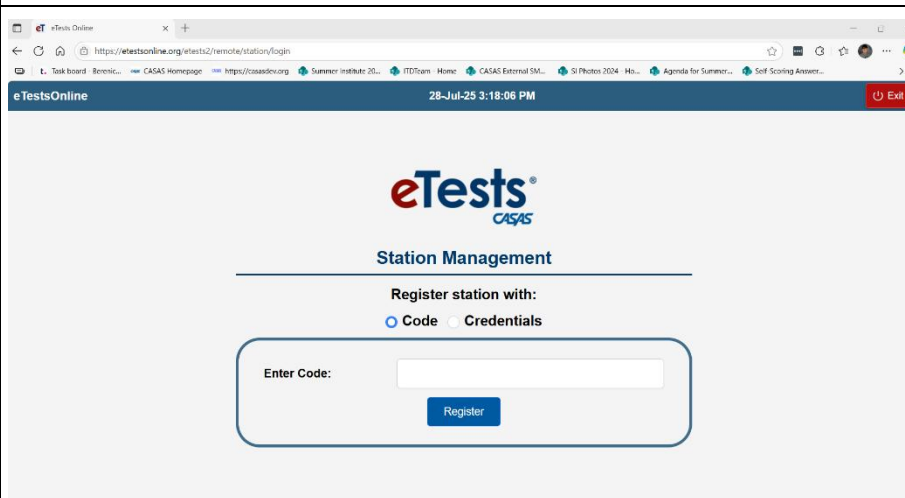
- Click on this link:

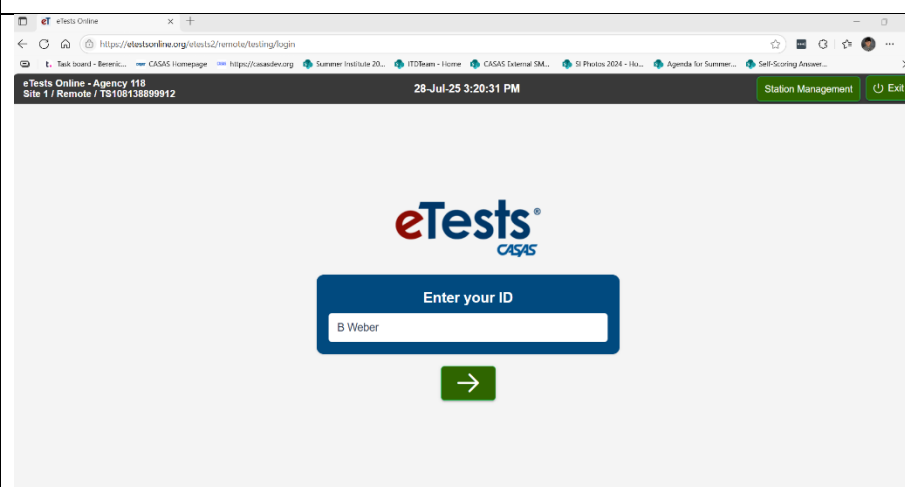
3 Click on the green “Take a Test” button




4 Type in the code that your proctor shares with you



5 Add your student ID next. Ask your proctor what your student ID is if you do not know.

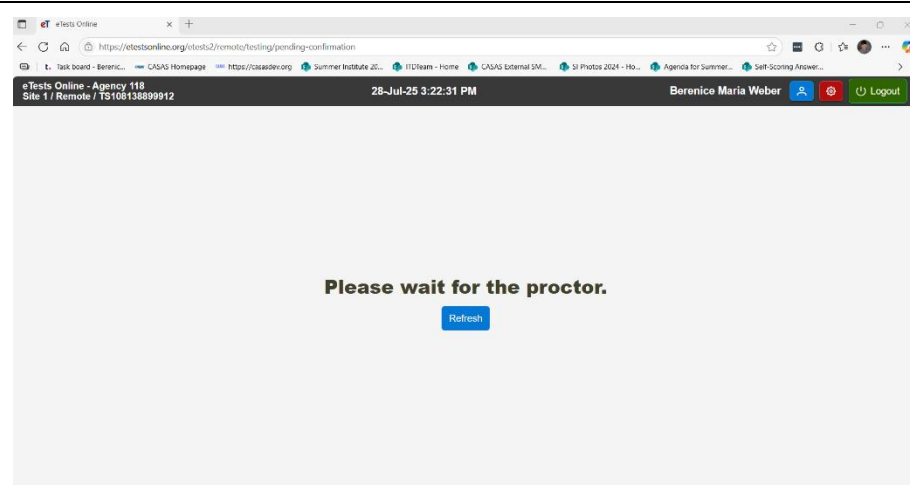


- 6 If you need to type in information about yourself, click save.

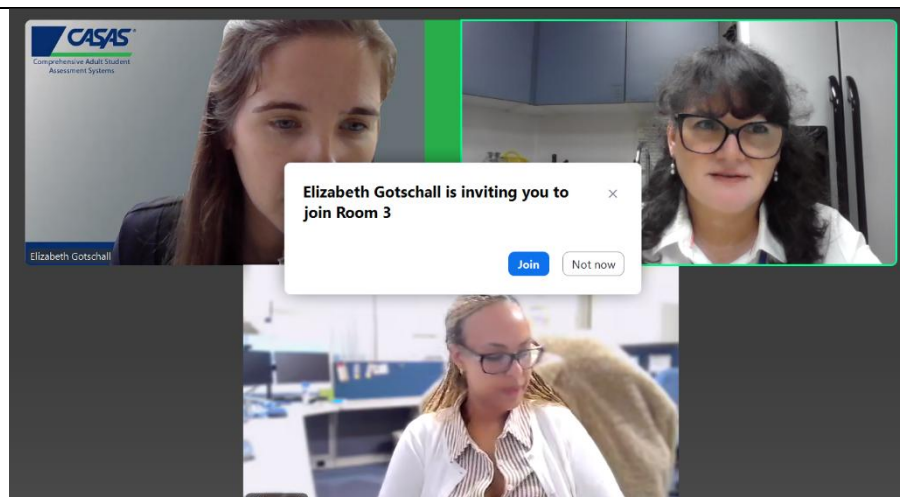

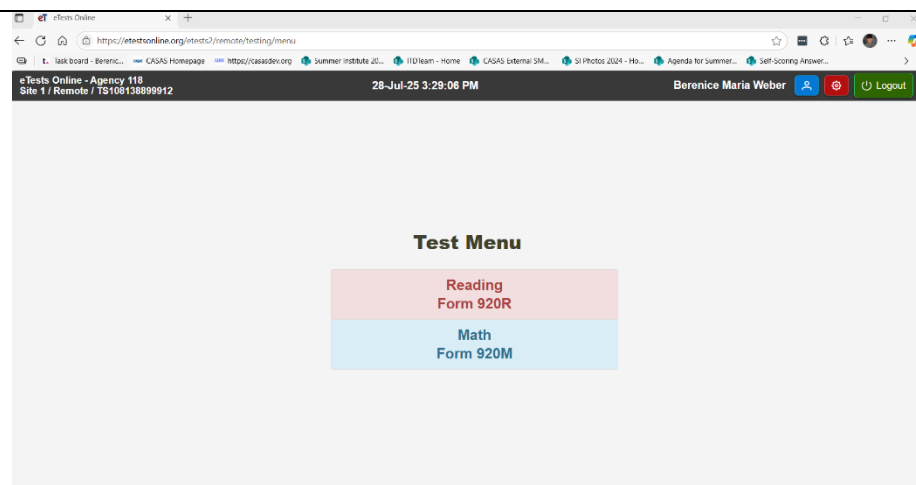
- 7 Wait for your proctor when you get to this screen.
