



CASAS tests are not "speeded" tests

That is, time limits should not have a negative effect on performance. The test administration time has been determined so that a time limit will not affect the performance of the vast majority of students.

The times listed should allow students to complete as much of the tests as they are capable of doing in one sitting. Test administrators may allow students an additional minute or two to finish the question they are working on.

The test administration time does not include time for entering demographic information in eTests or filling out the answer sheet for paper tests. The test administration time also does not include time for discussing the practice items prior to the test.

All CASAS tests have recommended test administration times. A clear understanding of the maximum testing time is essential for planning your testing schedule.
