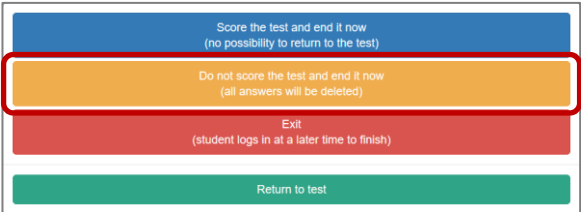
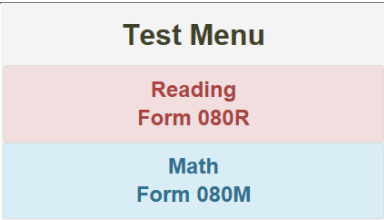
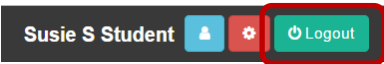
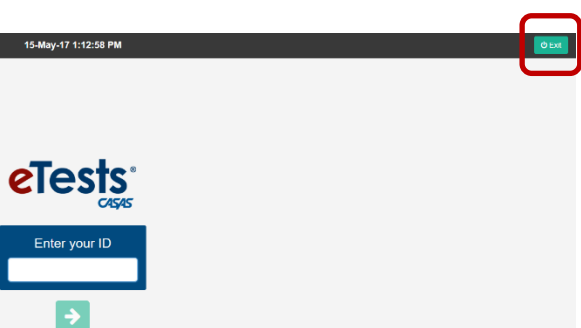


Steps to Abort a Test at the Testing Station

If a student just began taking a test and does not have enough time to complete the test in one sitting, or the test appears not to be the correct test for the student, you may interrupt and **Abort the Test** in progress. Aborting a test may be done at the **Testing Station** or at the **Management Console**.

Step	Screen	Description
1.	 <p><i>Note!</i> There is no possibility for the student to return to the test.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At the Testing Station, <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use the Ctrl + E key-command. From the pop-up, <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Click Do not score the test and end it now. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The test is deleted.
2.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Test Menu is reset and ready for the student to proceed as directed by the proctor.*
3.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If the student will not take any more tests, <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The student will Logout.
4.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The application returns to the Main screen. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Testing Station remains active for the next student to begin testing – i.e., Enter ID. If no further testing will take place – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> EXIT the Testing Station at top right. STOP the Testing Session at the Management Console.
5.	<p><i>*Note!</i> If the Aborted test was incorrect for the student,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The proctor must consult the testing coordinator for assistance before the student may begin another test. The testing coordinator may need to override the next-assigned test if necessary or direct the proctor to test the student with a different session.
