Implementation Examples

Option 1 – 600* test units x \$2.20 = \$1,320

Option 2 – 600* test units x \$2.20 + \$1,995 TE license = \$3,315

*100 students x 6 tests (one pre- and one post-test for reading, listening, and math)

CASAS eTests gives you the ability to combine a Locator and pretest in one sitting. Locators replace the Appraisal and are administered at no cost (or test unit). Locators quickly determine an appropriate-level pretest that is administered immediately following.

TOPSpro Enterprise (TE) eases data collection and provides opportunities to analyze and interpret data and identify specific solutions to improve performance outcomes. Use TE for automated test scoring, learner management, accountability, and reporting. The <u>Assessment and Database Management Features</u> document describes the differences between TE Basic and TE Enhanced implementation.
