Testing Guidelines & MSGs

- **Post-testing**
 - Administer post-test(s) after 70 -100 hours of instruction but not less than 40 hours
- **Pre- and Post-tests:** Must be from the same series
- **New series:** Establishes a new baseline
- **MSGs:** Only one per year

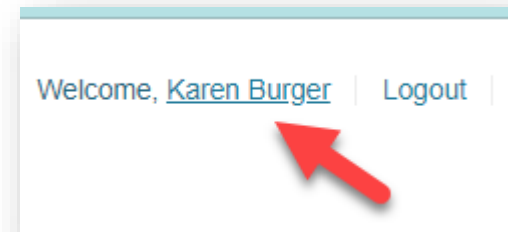
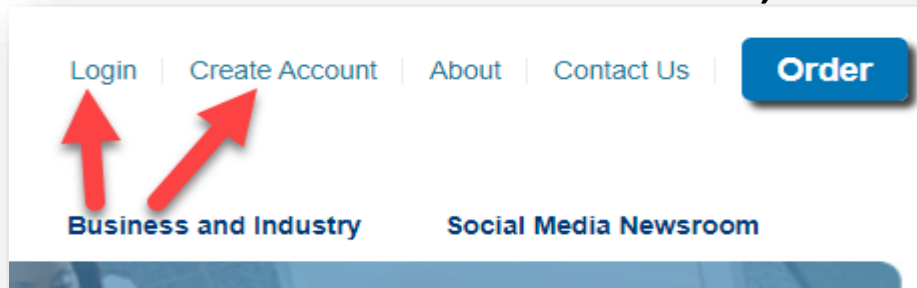

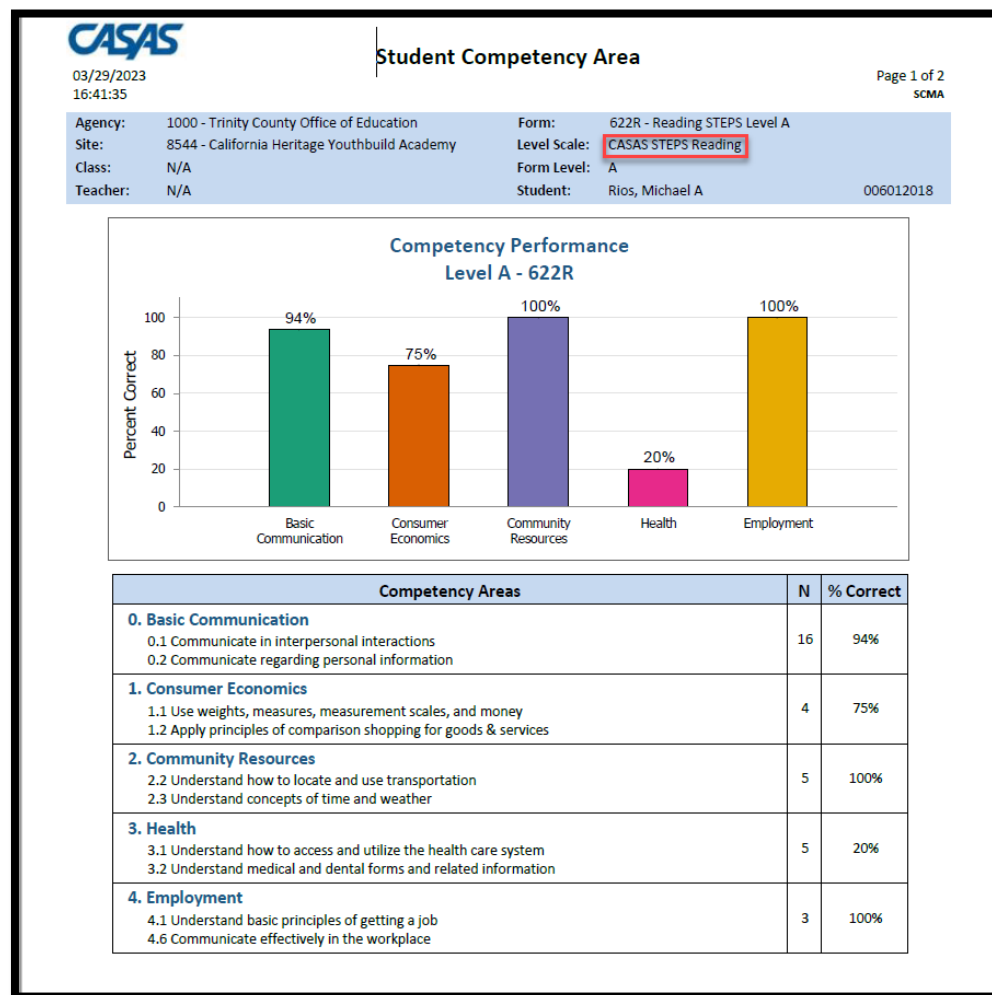

New Assessments = New Reports!

Student Competency Area Report

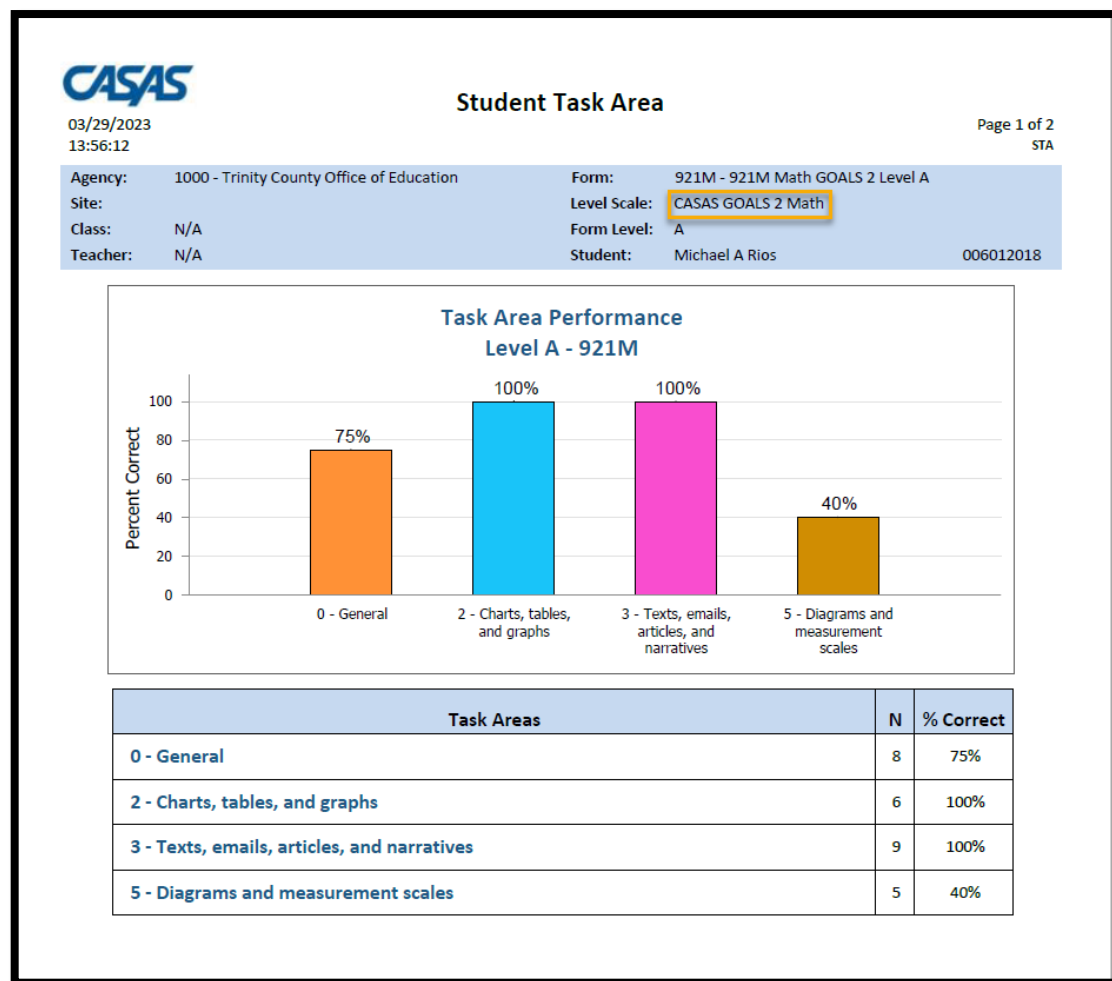
- Create vocabulary lists for health-related topics
- Find posters for a local health screening clinic and have student pairs identify who, what, when, where
- Review local urgent care clinic website for location, hours, services, etc.



New Assessments = New Reports

Student Task Area Report

- Review several measurement scales together: pain scales, elevation of location, etc., re-arrange graphics in logical order.
- Class works in small groups to create a measurement scales for salsa: mild to Kaboom!
- Discuss a diagram of Greenhouse Effect. Students create notes to explain each element of the diagram.



Tips for Launching the New Test Series

Step 1: Map Your Assets

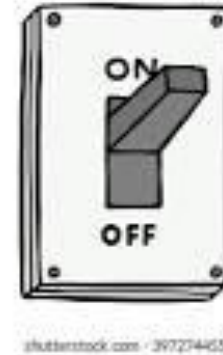
Considerations:

- Be mindful that you need paired scores from the same series
- Custom your launch based on the size and available resources for your school or agency
- Reflect on how this change might affect your student onboarding/orientation

Possible Launch Scenarios

- 1) Flipping the Switch
- 2) Farming Schedule
- 3) Blooming Rose

Flip the Switch



For example: Beginning Fall of 2023 everyone switches to the new assessment

- Pilot the test in small batches in the summer with the expectation that the full school or agency will fully transition in the new school year.
- Variation: One site flips the switch and then shares learning with the other sites throughout the year.

Farming Schedule



- **For example: Launch date is July of 2024**
- Summer – Plan your launch
- Fall – Communicate that a new assessment is coming and why
- Winter – Provide professional development opportunities to key stakeholders
- Spring – Conduct a small test pilot

Blooming Rose



- **For Example: Launch date is July 2023**
- Designate the ESL Level One classes as your early adaptors. Students start with the new assessment and as they progress from level to level schools build out the usage of the new assessment to level two, level three, etc.

Recommendations:

- Saturate your stakeholders with information about what to expect.
- Ask your teachers to take the assessment
- Ask for volunteers to pilot the assessment
- Invite teachers to share the level appropriate sample questions with their students
- Create targeted PDs for specific audiences:
Administrators, Coordinators, Teachers

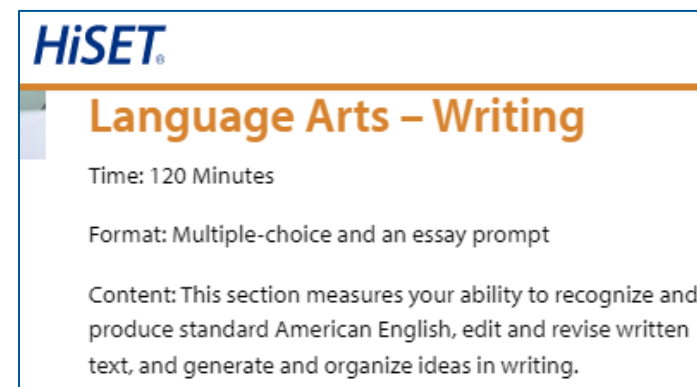
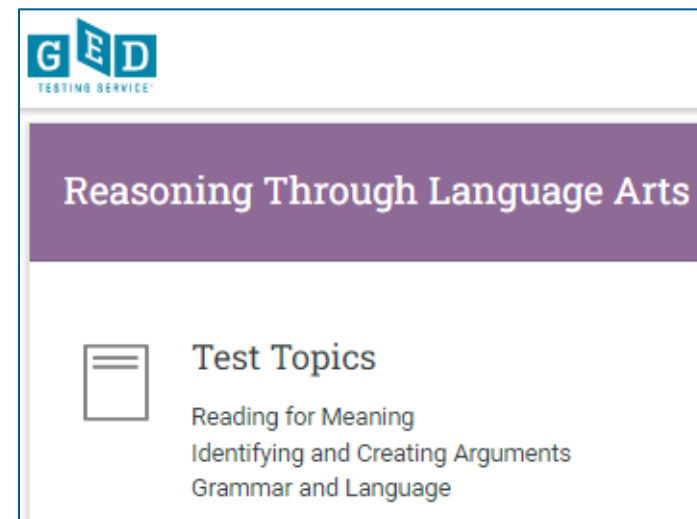

Becoming a Better Writer

Suggestions for Improvement:

Main Idea	When you write, make sure your main idea is clearly stated in the beginning. Focus on your main idea throughout the entire essay. Make sure that you include enough details and examples to support your main idea. Also, explain everything in your essay clearly so that the reader is not confused about what you mean. Extra information will help the reader understand what you are writing about.
Organization	Keep working on putting your sentences together in an organized way, so that your ideas are easy to follow. Using transition words will help to smoothly connect your ideas to each other.
Word Choice	Try to reduce the number of word-choice errors in your writing. Make sure that you are using words correctly, so the meaning is always clear. Also, use a variety of words and sentence structures in your writing. Avoid repetition where possible.
Grammar & Mechanics	Try to use more complex sentence structure throughout your essay. Also, continue to check your sentences carefully and fix any errors in grammar, spelling, capitalization, and punctuation. Fixing these errors will help the reader understand what you are saying.

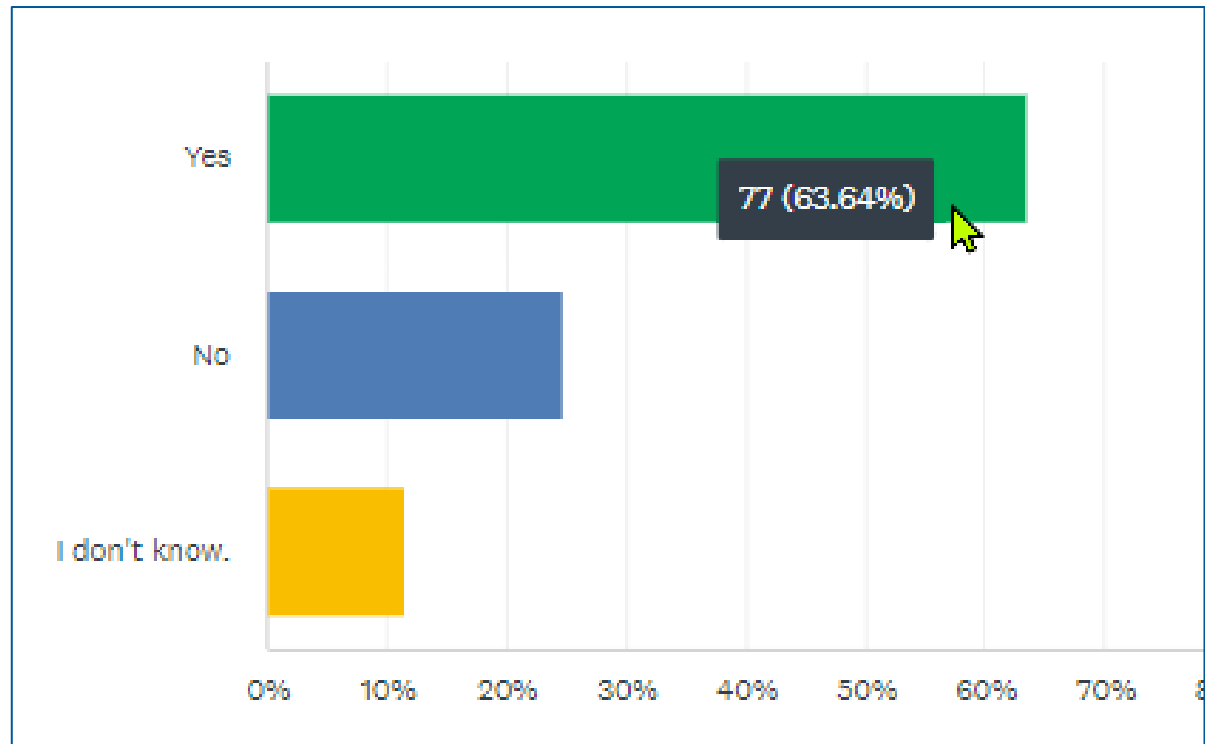



Why Take a Test?



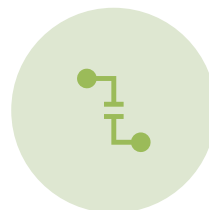
Provides the same functions as secure browser

Reduces time and resources for maintenance

Secure Browser vs. Kiosk Mode

Secure Browser

- Locks down test station
- Downloads before testing
- Interacts with firewall
- Runs in the background

Kiosk Mode

- Locks down test station
- Is built into Operating System
- Does not interact w/firewall
- Nothing runs in background
