



New Remote Testing Policy – Up to 15 Students at a Time

- For the past year, CASAS has been piloting remote testing with more than 5 students at a time.
- We are pleased to announce that CASAS has updated our policy for testing multiple students at the same time remotely, effective immediately.



New Remote Testing Policy Guidelines-Up to 15 Students at a Time

- Remote testing more than 1 student at a time continues to be limited to Approach 2 and 3 in which the student uses a Windows PC, a Chromebook with kiosk mode, or an iPad with secure guided access enabled.
- Proctors who are new to or who have limited
 experience with eTests or remote testing should
 test no more than 5 students at a time in one remote
 test session.



New Remote Testing Policy Guidelines-Up to 15 Students at a Time

- Proctors who are experienced in remote testing may test up to 15 students at a time in one remote test session – but only if they are comfortable doing this.
- These proctors should have at least three months
 experience using remote testing Approach 2 or 3 with
 up to 5 students simultaneously, and
- a total of at least 30+ completed assessments during
 10 different testing sessions.



New Remote Testing Policy Guidelines-Up to 15 Students at a Time

• The Remote Testing Guidelines for Approach 2 and 3 have been updated to reflect this new policy.

Remote Testing FAQ #41 has been revised.

Benefits of Field Testing

For Students

- Provides students with added confidence in test-taking experiences.
- Gives students an idea of test items.
- Reduces anxiety for students.

For Agency and Teachers

- Can be included as instructional time.
- Teachers can preview the new tests.
- Teachers can use the opportunity to coach students as they prepare for post-tests



New Math GOALS Final Forms Testing – URGENT NEED!

- When? Now and through June 30, 2022
- Who? ABE and ASE Learners
 - ESL students at NRS Level 4, 5 & 6 in Reading
 - All levels are needed
- Delivery? eTests and paper/pencil (on site and remote)
- Methodology? Locator/Appraisal + one or two level tests
- Student gift cards: \$20 per test
- Complimentary web-test units



Paper Testers and Learning Gains Studies

- Students take a pre- and post-test
- Needed for ESL and Math
- Paper/Pencil or eTests

Paper / Pencil Field Testing

- Math
- Listening



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- Can field test results be used for reporting purposes?
 - No, they are in development and not NRS approved.
- Will field testing affect my regular program testing?
 - No. they will not show up on reports
 - Practice tests to help prepare for post-testing.
- What if my student is not in a math class?
 - All students that meet criteria are eligible if they are part of your adult education program even if they are not currently studying math.



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- How will we access the field tests?
 - We will put a specially configured testing session in your eTests account.
- Will my program need to pay for the field tests? Or will the test use my program's WTUs?
 - No cost. Field tests do not use WTUs. Paper tests are shipped to you with prepaid return labels.
- How will students get the gift cards?
 - CASAS orders Target or Walmart gift cards; mailed directly to your agency for distribution to students.







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Features of "Basic" TOPSpro Enterprise

- → Individual Student Skills Profile
- → Individual Student Competency Performance
- Personal Score Report (at end of test)
- → Test History -- of all test takers
 - CASAS test form, test date, scale score, and scores outside of accuracy range
- Next Assigned Test
- → Test Administrations -- # of tests given per month
- ⇒ Export student test data to 3rd Party data system




Features of "Enhanced" TOPSpro Enterprise

- Student Level Class Reports (Content Standards, Competencies)
- Monitor program effectiveness
 - Class, Site and Agency Data Reports
 - Track clients in multiple programs
 - "Special Programs" feature
- Record instructional hours
- Drill-down: reports-to-data
- Customizable listers, Ad hoc reporting
- State and Federal accountability reporting (NRS Fed Tables)
