

CAHSEE Mathematics Readiness Test

The CAHSEE Mathematics Readiness Test is a tool to help inform students of their readiness to take and pass the math portion of the California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE). The results from the test allow instructors to estimate each student's readiness to take the CAHSEE. In addition, the test results allow instructors to identify the content standards or competencies the student did not perform well on and where additional preparation may be needed. The CAHSEE Mathematics Readiness Test can also provide the student with valuable test-taking practice prior to taking the math portion of the CAHSEE.

Because the CAHSEE Mathematics Readiness Test is on the same scale as other CASAS tests, instructors may use student performance on other CASAS tests to help determine when it would be beneficial to administer the CAHSEE Mathematics Readiness Test to a student.

The CAHSEE Mathematics Readiness Test is strictly a readiness test and is not designed as a test to measure progress or learning gains. There are no pre- and post-test versions of the test.
