

Notes for presenting

You may present all or parts of the PowerPoint at one time. You may present the handbook over a one- or two-day time period.

You may present the sections (matched with the sections of the handbook) in the order presented or in an order based on the needs of your agency.

CASAS testing is presented in two sections of the handbook.

- Section 6 is an overview (or "big picture") of CASAS testing and how to interpret CASAS scale scores.
- Section 8 goes into greater detail about administering tests, how to use pre- and post-tests, and similar information.
 - Section 8 is a very large section, so plan to schedule at least two hours to present this information.
