CASAS eTests Online: Basic Reports

Included with purchase of online test administrations (Web-test units/WTUs), CASAS eTests Online provides eight basic reports generated through TOPSpro Enterprise Online:

1. [Individual Skills Profile - John Morris](#)
(For GED programs) presents competencies assessed in various modalities and indicates likelihood of passing different GED subsections.
[Individual Skills Profile - Maria Gonzalez](#)
(For ESL programs) presents competencies assessed in reading and listening.
2. [Student Competency Performance - Reading](#)
[Student Competency Performance - Math](#)
Shows test results of an individual test-taker on a given test form by displaying the competency number and statement for each test item and indicating whether the test-taker correctly answered the item.
3. [Personal Score Report](#) (PSR)
Shows test results summary and scale score descriptor of an individual test-taker on a given test form; optional on-screen display at the end of a test with print option. Print or reprint individually or filtered group from TE Online.
4. [Student Test Summary](#)
Lists, by agency or site, every test-taker who has taken a test and displays the test history for each test-taker – including CASAS test form, test date, scale score, hours of instruction, and scores outside the accuracy range.
5. [Test Results](#)
Lists test records for a specified date range – including CASAS test form, test date, and scale score.
6. [Next-Assigned Test](#) (NAT)
Lists students with their last CASAS test form, scale score, and test date. Based on the previous test result, this report displays, by modality, the next-assigned test (NAT) form and level for the specified date range.
7. [eTests Administrations](#)
Lists information about number of tests administered per month for each program year.
8. [WTU Gauge](#)
Dashboard indicator of test administrations available for use with agency-defined “low” threshold (coming soon).
