

TOPSpro Record Color Codes




TOPSpro uses different colors to highlight records that may be missing key data elements.

Red - Invalid Records




Red records indicate *invalid* records and pertain to all TOPSpro records.

Valid Records

- **⊃** In order to be valid in TOPSpro, a record must include the following mandatory five fields:
 - 1. Student ID number
 - 2. Record Date
 - 3. Class ID number
 - 4. Instructional Program
 - 5. Test Form number

Yellow – Incomplete Records



Yellow records indicate incomplete records and pertain to all TOPSpro records.




The TOPSpro user determines which records will be complete & which will be incomplete in Required Fields.

Yellow Records in Entry Lister




Yellow records that appear in the Entry Lister or in Batch Repair – Entry Records indicate *incomplete Entry Records (fields 10-20)*.

Blue Records




Blue records only appear in the Entry Lister and Batch Repair—Entry Records and indicate *incomplete* Student Records (Entry fields 3-9).

Pink Records




Pink records are only in the Entry Lister and Batch Repair—Entry Records and indicate *incomplete* Student and Entry Records.

Magenta Records




Magenta records are only in the Test Lister and Batch Repair—Test Records and indicate unapproved additional assessments.

Aqua Records



Aqua records are only in Batch Repair – Test Records and indicate Multiple Item responses.

Brown Records



Brown records only appear in the Update Lister and Batch Repair—Update Records and indicate imported attendance hours.
